Do You Know the Warning Signs for Autism?

Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASDs) can sometimes show signs as early as nine months. Early diagnosis and intervention are key with ASDs.

Some indicators to watch out for in toddlers include:

- Delayed speech
- Not responding to their name or making eye contact
- Body movements like rocking or hand flapping
- Babbling that sounds like humming or whining
- An unusual fixation on a particular object, like a toy
- Losing a gained ability, such as speech
